If accepted the actual start date will depend on the nature of the repair work, available funding and volunteers, the time of the year, weather, prepayment of fee, and other factors.

The Repair Program is designed to help families age in place and improve their living conditions by making repairs that are focused on health, safety, accessibility, and improvements to the overall neighborhood

Habitat for Humanity's policy is a hands-up and not a handout, so we expect the families to participate with sweat equity and pay a \$50 Fee.
